

Project's Description

Homage to the Emigrants of Isaba (Navarra - Spain) who went to New México (USA), and to the Sisterhood of the villages: Isaba and Vaughn/New México.

(V-19)

Managed for the "Asociación PRO ISABA & NEWMEXICO - ISABA". This project can be resumed as follows:

1. GOALS

History makes it evident to us that Isaba's people, at the beginnings of the XX Century, were all integrated in one social group. At a given moment, and for reasons unknown to us, some of Isaba's citizens started to migrate (we have, as of today some 93 names for these emigrants in our records) towards the U.S., specifically towards some New México territory. Starting then, and for a period of about 100 years, it started an almost imperceptible but increasing separation between the Isaba - Vaughn social groups; i.e. the people of Isaba still residing in Isaba (Isaba/Isaba), and the emigrants, and their descendants, of Isaba in New México(USA) (Isaba/New México, USA). This separation comes to the point of an almost total break between these two groups at the start of the XXI Century.

This Project has two goals: one to be accomplished shortly, and the second one to be accomplished later.

1.1. SHORT RANGE PROJECT (year 2010) - to be resumed as:

- Homage to the Isaba's Emigrants (i.e. only those born at Isaba), who contributed in one or another form, to the development of the area of New México where they reside or resided
- Formalize the Sisterhood project of the two social groups Isaba/Isaba and Isaba/New México-USA.
- To promote the spanish language in the Countys of NewMéxico and the English in Isaba-Navarra
- To develop and promote the tourism between Isaba-Navarra and the County of NewMéxico
- The concentrations in Isaba y Vaughn, in Mayo 2.010

1.2.- LONG RANGE PROJECT - To continue the development of the two social groups Isaba/Isaba and Isaba/New México after these groups have been established and sisterhood has been accomplished.

For it the interchanges cultural, language, turistic and social were fomented between New México and Isaba (Valle del Roncal - Navarra). These interchanges will be a good base for the communication between the descendants of the emigrants and those of the brothers who were in [#]Isaba.

It is, then necessary, once the goal for the year 2010 has been accomplished, that we continue our work to avoid a total break between the two groups. We want to facilitate communication between social groups, or clubs, and individual belonging to both groups.

Steps to take to make this road an accessible one:

- To promote the tourism between Isaba and New México, as way to facilitate the understanding of both societies

- To promote the bilingualism as bow of union between this two societies
- Promover el bilingüismo como lazo de unión entre sociedades
- Inter exchange of University students
- Language Classes with students residing with families on both sides of the ocean
- Mutual works investigating the history of both groups
- Systematic Relations (every 5 years, as an example) between the participating institutions
- A Picture show and contest (using Internet) with photos of the flora and the fauna of both countries
- Mutual collaboration on projects of human, scientific and economic Interest
- Essays relating to make evident agreements and disagreements through time of both social groups
- Bilingual Poetry Contests
- Artistic (Paintings) Contests
- Exchange of folkloric shows (Choral groups, musical concerts, Theatrical plays, etc)
- Tourist visits, and grants or fellowships

2. NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION

To attain the goals established above, we are in need of three different types of information:

2.1.- ABOUT THE EMIGRANTS - We need not only their full name and that of their parents and grandparents, but as much information about them as possible.

We need all of this to complete our records as much as possible

2.2.- ABOUT THE ORIGINAL HOME OF THE EMIGRANTS- We want to find out about the family (descendents) of the Emigrants and that of their brothers. This "Family Picture" will make it possible for us to evaluate the personal sacrifice for each home at the moment the emigration took place.

There were homes where, four out of five brothers emigrated.

This will allow us to leave a record for future generations.

2.3.- ABOUT THE EMIGRANT'S DESCENDENTS AND THOSE OF THEIR BROTHERS - For us, to become acquainted with all the direct descendents and the descendents of their brothers, will allow to leave a record for future generations and their relationship with the Emigrants and, on the other hand, to have access to postal and e-mail addresses, of all those who appear in the "Family Picture", and will make it possible to continue providing others with periodical information about the Project's progress.

By virtue of these steps, we will be able to gather everyone, in the year 2010, for all the acts we are planning, so both groups can maintain contact with each other.

3. TIME FRAME

We have been working on this project since 29.10.2005, when the first working group became organized in Isaba.

We are including here the Plan as presented in 2005 which, as of today, has not been modified, though its being carried out is somewhat ahead of what we had foreseen.

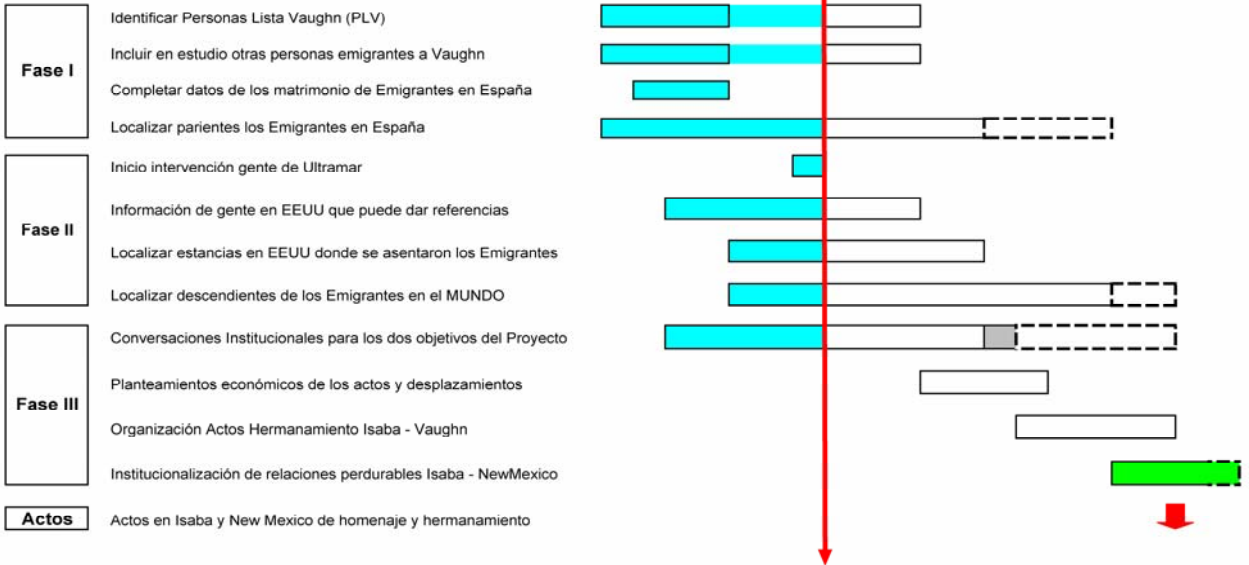
